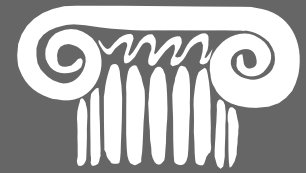

The **Firehouse Gallery at Genesee Pottery** is seeking original ceramic work from emerging artists currently enrolled in a college program. Work may be functional or sculptural. Mixed media work must be predominantly ceramics.

## Rules of Entry:

**Eligibility:** Open to all students currently enrolled in a college program. Work must be display-ready upon arrival. All work must be available for sale.

**Entry fee:** \$10 for 3 entries & \$15 for 5.

**Awards: First** is \$150 clay/glazes from **Studio Sales (www.studiosalespottery.com)**

**Second** is \$100.00 gift card from **Clayscapes (www.clayscapespottery.com)**

**Shipping:** Certified return shipping requested. Participants are responsible for all shipping and insurance expenses. Work must be sent in a substantial, reusable packing crate or box. Hand delivery is accepted.

Any artwork with no pre-paid return that is not picked up after 30 of the close of the exhibition becomes the property of the Genesee Pottery.

- **Deadline Jan. 30th**
- **Notification March 2nd - 6th**
- **Work due March 16th-20th**
- **Opening night April 3rd**
- **Pick up April 27th-May 2**

**Format:** Digital images should be high-quality jps that accurately represent the piece being submitted. Jps must be submitted on a CD and saved with a file name as follows: your initials followed by the number of your entry, and a descriptive title. (For example, a blue bowl by Bob Smith would be titled BS 01 Blue Bowl.) File size should be at 300 dpi and no larger than 1 mb.

**Deadline:** All entries are due to the Genesee Pottery by **January 30th, 2009.**

**Delivery:** All accepted work is due to the Gallery the week of March 16—20.

Genesee Pottery retains a 50% commission on all sales. Prices provided by the artist are assumed to include the Gallery commission. All sales will be handled by the Genesee Pottery.

Every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition, and return of the work, but the Genesee Pottery, its employees and volunteers, and the Genesee Center for the Arts and Education. will assume no responsibility for any loss or damage incurred. It is recommended that artists carry their own insurance during shipping and exhibition.
